ACTIONS TO CLOSE THE GAP (page 30)

- 1. The DE committee should submit its plan for spring 2014 to the EPC and College Council. The plan should include at minimum the following elements.
 - a. Through program review and the resource allocation process evaluate and improve DE offerings
 - 1. Analysis of student performance
 - 2. Results of student evaluations
 - 3. Periodic assessment of current and prospective DE students
 - 4. Assessment of counseling and all student support services
 - 5. Assessment of criteria to evaluate course shells
 - 6. Assessment of ongoing adherence to applicable federal and state regulations, ACCJC standards, and board policies
 - 7. Broad based dialogue
 - 8. Recommendations for improvement
 - 9. Resource requests to implement improvements
 - b. Set goals and measurable objectives
 - c. Periodic review of DE policies and procedures
 - d. Ensure information is clear and accurate
 - e. Evaluate, re-design, and regularly maintain website
 - f. Maintain linkages with other college plans such as educational master plan and technology
 - g. Establish provisions for regular evaluations of DE plan itself based on student achievement and student learning
 - h. Disseminate plan to the college community
- 2. Ensure that DE faculty are entering assessment reports
- 3. DE committee should develop and recommend to EPC a more detailed charter consistent with the requirements of article 40.
- 4. DE committee should evaluate reassigned time for DE coordinator
- 5. The college should consider a separate cost center and budget for DE
